

Formal Requirements for Presentations/ Papers at the microCAD International Scientific Conference

TITLE

(capital letters, bold type, set in the middle of the text body, (14))
(line feed)

Authors' Name (Sandra Marked¹, Werner Taylor², Roland G. Rowling³)
(italic, bold type in the middle of the text body, (13))

scientific degree, position (13) (in order the marking number)
in the middle of the text body

affiliation (13) (in order the marking number) *italic type letters*
in the middle of the text body
(line feed)

The text is indented by six spaces. It should be typed on A/4 size white copy paper (margins: left 3 cm, others 2,5 cm). (Times New Roman font type, size 13). There should be no pagination, the number of the page should be marked by pencil on the back of the page.

Please, do not number the pages!!!

- ◆ No line(s) feed between paragraphs, the typing should be continuous.
- ◆ HEADINGS should be in capitals with a blank line preceding and following them.
- ◆ Within chapters, subheadings should be italicised with a blank line preceding and following them.
- ◆ Formulae
$$A=AA+BB*c$$
 should be set in the middle and the height of the characters should be identical to that of the letters in the text. Formulae should be numbered in parentheses, with a blank line preceding and following them.
- ◆ Lists should be treated as chapters and numbered in the decimal system (1.1.1). Unmarked (unnumbered) lists should begin each item with a dash.
- ◆ Figures should be inserted in the text with a blank line preceding and following them. Figures should be numbered consecutively throughout the text with numbers set below the figure, if necessary with a caption, set in the middle. The size of the characters should not be smaller than those in the text.

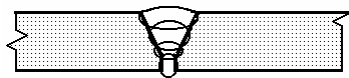
